

5 DAY PRIVATE GUIDED ETOSHA & SWAKOPMUND TOUR



Day 1 - 26 June 2009 or 04 July 2009

Collection from your central Windhoek accommodation establishment for an early morning departure - northbound.

Travel via Outjo into Etosha National Park, where we undertake the first game drive in our touring vehicle. Just before sunset we will leave the Park and drive to our safari camp outside the Park.

Lunch en route (for guests' own account)

ETOSHA SAFARI CAMP on DBB basis or similar

Day 2 – 27 June 2009 or 05 July 2009

Day excursion into the Park. Except for the rainy season, Etosha's animals are dependent on artificial waterholes and natural springs. Explore the various waterholes along this enormous saltpan, which is called the "great white place of dry water" in a local language.

Of the 114 mammals species found in the Park, several are rare and endangered like the black rhino of the black faced impala.

Lunch stop at one of the rest camps (*included*).

ETOSHA SAFARI CAMP on DBB basis or similar

Day 3 – 28 June 2009 or 06 July 2009

Depart Etosha Safari Camp and travel south-west towards the coast, via the small towns of Outjo, Khorixas, the old mining town – Uis and the coastal town of Henties Bay.

Lunch en route (for guests' own account)

Upon arrival in Swakopmund, guests can explore the lovely town.

Enjoy the Atlantic seafood in one of the many restaurants.

SWAKOPMUND HOTEL (luxury) on BB basis or similar

Day 4 – 29 June 2009 or 07 July 2009

At 07H00 guests will be transferred from their accommodation establishment, to Walvis Bay for a Marine Cruise.

Upon completion of the Marine Cruise, guests will be transferred back to Swakopmund.

Lunch in either Walvis Bay or Swakopmund (lunch for guests' own account).

SWAKOPMUND HOTEL (luxury) on BB basis or similar

Day 5 – 30 June 2009 or 08 July 2009

Depart Swakopmund and travel inland towards the towns of Usakos and Karibib. We continue towards Windhoek via Okahandja where we could visit the handcraft market. This is a good place to purchase a hand carved item.

The tour ends on arrival in Windhoek around lunch time.

You will be dropped-off at your central Windhoek accommodation establishment.
